



Reading Plan - The Gospel of Luke

This reading plan is intended to follow with our teaching series in the Gospel of Luke. Some weeks will have more scripture than others, depending on the events and principles being presented in the text.

Feel free to break up the text into sections that you read each day, based on the number of days you read, and the number of verses in that week's reading. We suggest at least five days per week.

As you begin each day:

1. Find a quiet place where you can be alone. This is important for you to more easily focus as you read and have an awareness of God's presence. Prepare yourself to listen.
2. Pray before you start, asking God to speak to you through His word.
3. Read the verses and highlight the main points that stand out to you. Keep a journal of important things you learn and pray about in this process.
4. Be intentional about thinking and praying about the points you wrote down throughout your day.
